This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing the impugned order/rejection letter dated 23.1.2020, vide which the loan application of the petitioner has been rejected.

A bare perusal of the paper book shows that the case pertains to the financial prudence of the bank qua its business. The Court would be loath to interfere in the matter against the assessment by the bank officials. Still further, the case involves lot of disputed questions of facts, which this Court cannot assess by any means.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
