The grievance of the petitioner in this case is that there are certain interpretational anomalies in the policy framed by the Government of Punjab with regard to providing jobs to the kin of those who were posthumously granted Gallantry Awards. He claims to have submitted representation dated 23.12.2019 in this regard to the respondent authorities but asserts that no action was taken thereon.

As it is for the authorities concerned to address the issues raised by the petitioner in his representation and take appropriate action, as warranted, no cause is made out for this Court to entertain this writ petition for adjudication on merits.

Ms. Anju Arora, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, would also assure this Court that the needful would be done by the authorities concerned, duly taking note of the contents of the petitioner's representation.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the respondent-authorities to consider the petitioner's representation dated 23.12.2019 and take appropriate measures to introduce clarity in the subject policy, if required. This exercise shall be completed expeditiously and in any event, not later than three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
