This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, in case FIR No. 0121 dated 19.05.2020, under Sections 307/34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar-Rural, District-Amritsar.

[2]. Petitioner was arrested on 12.07.2020. After completion of investigation, Challan against him has already been submitted. Trial is yet to commence. Charges have not been framed. It is seen from the impugned order passed by the Ld. Sessions Judge, Amritsar that the injuries attributed to the petitioner on his brother were otherwise found to be simple in nature.

[3]. As such, without commenting any further on the merits of the

present case as a whole and in view of the detention undergone by the petitioner, as also the fact that the trial is likely to take its own substantial time, particularly on account of the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned
