The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to conclude the proceedings in the cross-version case registered vide G.D. No.33 dated 08.09.2020 under Sections 384, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Mohkampura, Amritsar, District Amritsar, Annexure P-2, in case FIR No.165 dated 09.08.2020 registered under Sections 341 and 506 IPC at Police Station Mohkampura, Amritsar, District Amritsar, Annexure P-1.

In response to the notice of motion, the State has filed a copy of the status report by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Headquarters, Amritsar wherein it has been submitted that detailed investigation has been carried out and recommendation for the cancellation

of the above cross-case has been made by the Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police, City-3, Amritsar. It has been further submitted that final investigation report (cancellation) under Section 173 Cr.P.C., shall be presented before the Court after completing procedural formalities.

In view of the aforesaid development, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail alternative remedy, in accordance with law.

The original attested affidavit be filed by the State within a period of four weeks.
