Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though, the petitioner had cleared the examination under the interim order of this Court passed in LPA-1513-2017 dated 18.08.2017 (Annexure P-7), hence, he should be only allowed to clear the remaining subjects, rather than being asked to undergo the complete studies of the semester once again by the respondent University.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 22.09.2020 (Annexure P-9) with respondent No.1, which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to

respondent No.1 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief, which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 22.09.2020 (Annexure P-9), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the representation dated 22.09.2020 (Annexure P-9) within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
