The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 4.3.2011, passed by Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar, vide which the petitioner was declared Proclaimed Offender in case FIR No.69 dated 12.6.2010, under Section 307, 326, 324, 323, 34 IPC, Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the application for bail filed by the petitioner was declined by the Court of Sessions on 28.1.2011 and thereafter he left India. He fairly states that the father of the petitioner stands convicted through judgement dated 9.8.2011.

The above facts clearly indicate that the petitioner was well aware of the case proceedings and therefore, knowingly remained away from the trial.

Resultantly, no case is made out for exercise of inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed.
