In the present petition, order dated 14.10.2020 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.1 has been challenged on the ground that respondent No.1 did not had any jurisdiction to entertain the appeal keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.2 has also filed a contempt petition alleging the disobedience of the order dated 14.10.2020 (Annexure P-6) in which, notice has been issued by respondent No.1. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that there is no provision under the rules and regulations for initiating contempt proceedings by respondent No.1 and hence, the impugned order may kindly be set aside.

On being pointed out whether, the petitioner has approached respondent No.1 with the objection/explanation or not before approaching this Court, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be allowed to

withdraw the present petition, at this stage, with liberty to raise all the possible objections with regard to the maintainability of the appeal filed by respondent No.2 before respondent No.1 and initiation of contempt proceedings.

Ms. Rajni Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, submits that she has instructions from respondent No.1 that in case, any objection to the maintainability of the appeal/reply is filed by the petitioner in respect of the order dated 14.10.2020 (Annexure P-6), the same will be disposed of within a period of 10 days from filing of the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition, keeping in view the above statement of learned counsel for the respondent-State, with liberty to avail appropriate remedy by approaching respondent No.1, at this stage, for redressal of the grievance of the petitioner.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.
