The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the respondents to deliver the possession of the plot which was allotted on lease hold basis vide letter No.11.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) issued by respondent No.6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 –Deputy Commissioner, Sirsa District Sirsa to consider and decide the representation dated 26.10.2020 (Annexure P-4 ) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has already been handed over to the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 –Deputy Commissioner, Sirsa District Sirsa to consider and decide the

representation dated 26.10.2020 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law within eight weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of four weeks thereafter in accordance with law. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
