Petitioner has filed the present criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect her life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the relief claimed in the present criminal writ petition, the petitioner has already filed a representation dated 02.11.2020(Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Amit Mehta, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply

Without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of, at this stage, with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, District Fazilka, to take note on the representation, if so received by him(i.e. respondent No.2) and to act in accordance with law.

However, in case, such representation has not been received by respondent No.2, it shall not be incumbent upon respondent No.2 to take note on such representation, unless a fresh representation is filed by the petitioner within a period of 15 days from today.
