All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail', upon FIR no.59, dated 25.04.2015, having been registered at Police Station City Nawanshahar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 406 and 498-A of the IPC.

Though learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners' mother has been acquitted of similar charges framed against her, yet, the petitioner having been declared to be a proclaimed person, he obviously having jumped bail earlier granted to him, I see no reason to entertain this petition, which is consequently dismissed.

Upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial court and moving any

application under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., that would naturally be decided on its own merits.
