Case taken up through video conferencing.

Petitioner Manpreet Singh, aged about 23 years, resident of village Sachander, Tehsil and District Amritsar, Punjab has approached this Court by way of filing the instant Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India against respondents i.e. State of Punjab and others for issuance of a direction to Commissioner of Police, Amritsar (respondent No.2) to protect his life and liberty at the hands of private respondents contending that he had got registered an FIR No.61 dated 18.10.2019 for the offence under Sections 323, 326, 506, 148 and

149 IPC, registered with Police Station Airport against the private respondents since all of them had attacked him with deadly weapons causing grievous injuries to him. Now such private respondents are pressurizing him not to pursue the criminal case. According to him, he had submitted a representation dated 29.7.2020, copy Annexure P2, addressed to respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Amritsar in that regard, without evoking any response.

Notice of motion to respondent No.1 to 3.

Mr.J.S. Ghuman, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Amritsar is directed to consider the representation Annexure P-2 and take necessary action in the matter, within a fixed time frame.

Learned State counsel submits that the respondents No.1 to 3 would abide by any such order passed by this Court.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to consider the representation Annexure P-2 to take necessary action in the matter, if it is so warranted by facts and circumstances of the case, expeditiously.
