The petitioner has approached this Court through this writ petition with the grievance that legal notice dated 14.10.2020 (Annexure P-9) submitted by the petitioner-Society through its counsel with regard to the representation submitted claiming benefit under Section 101-A of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 has not been considered by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the claim of the petitioner would be covered by the judgment passed by this Court in **Raghubir Singh and another vs. State of Haryana and others** (CWP No.22241 of 2016 decided on 1.10.2020) and another connected case.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the fact that the aforesaid judgment also states that the aggrieved person can approach the State which

the petitioner has so done, it is, therefore, required from the respondents to consider the legal notice and pass a speaking order on the said legal notice.

Learned counsel for the State, under these circumstances, submits that decision would be taken by the competent authority amongst the respondents within a period of four weeks from today and decision so taken will be conveyed to the petitioner.

In the light of the above, the present petition is disposed of binding the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the legal notice of the petitioner (Annexure P-9) and the decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner within the time stipulated above.
