[1] Result of the petitioner in the BCA Category for the post of Mandi Supervisor-cum-Fee Collector, Agricultural Marketing Board, Panchkula, Haryana, advertisement No.07/2015, Category No.17, has been produced in Court in sealed cover along with the marks obtained by the last selected candidate in the respective category.

[2] Result on opening reveals that the petitioner has secured 136 marks out of 225 marks as against the 145 marks secured by the last selected candidate.

[3] Result of the petitioner, as has been produced in Court, as also the marks of the last selected candidate have been shown to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, he does not press the writ petition and the same may be disposed of, as such.

[4] In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** as not calling for any further orders.
