All the cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

On 10.11.2020, the following order had been passed:-

“All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR no.295, dated 1.10.2020, having been registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 420/406/120-B of the IPC and Section 4 of the Immigration Act, 1983.

When this court was not inclined to admit the petitioner to anticipatory bail, Mr.Saini, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the petitioner has some medical issues also, with him being otherwise a young man of 24 years of age, who is also a student.

Adjourned to 23.11.2020.

All medical certificates, from government hospitals, pertaining to any illness that the petitioner is suffering from, as also a certificate of his being a student in any recognized institution, be placed on record.

It is made clear that no notice of motion having been issued, obviously there is no interim order operating in favour of the petitioner at this stage.”

Thereafter yesterday, i.e. 23.11.2020, the following order had been passed:-

“All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

For learned counsel for the petitioner and the State to determine as to how much was the amount transferred by the complainant on his behalf to the account of the petitioner, i.e. Mandeep Saini, adjourned to 24.11.2020.”

Today learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
