The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail in case FIR No. 203 dated 22.10.2020, registered under Sections 420, 120 B IPC at Police Station Sector 34, Chandigarh.

FIR was lodged on the complaint of one Saraswati stating that she has paid a sum of Rs. 5,00,000/- to Sandeep Singh alias Sunny Virk on the promise by latter that he would secure a job for complainant in a bank. It is further alleged that Sandeep Singh alias Sunny Virk procured an appointment letter which was subsequently found to be forged.

Learned counsel for petitioner states that petitioner has no role in entire transaction. Petitioner is only an employee working with Sandeep Singh alias Sunny Virk in his office. Moreover, complainant herself compromised with petitioner.

In view thereof, no useful purpose will be served by detaining petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of trial. Accordingly, petition is allowed. Petitioner Paramjit Kaur alias Harpreet Kaur is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
