The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

The petitioner Satwant Singh aged about 67 years, through his SPoA Madan Lal has filed the present writ petition inter alia seeking a direction to decide the legal notice to pay Rs.20,68,800/- along with interest including compensation on account of delayed payment of retirement/pensionary dues.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner retired from the post of Assistant Development Officer in the year 2006. By making reference to para 3 of the petition, learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is entitled to revised pension but the same has not been paid to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the aforementioned grievance/demand, the petitioner has got served a legal notice dated 26.08.2020 (P3) which has not been decided by the authorities till date.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition by directing the competent authority to consider and decide the petitioner's claim as raised in legal notice (P3) as early as possible and preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
