Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioners at the outset without arguing submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the review application as well as the main revision petition.

In view of the above, the main revision petition is ordered to be listed today itself.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that in case the petitioners withdraw the revision petition, they will not claim the mesne profits as the possession has since been handed over by the petitioners to the respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute and admits that the possession has been handed over.

In view of the agreed position, both the review application as well as the revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn with a further direction that the respondent shall not press the order of mesne profits.
