26 Petitioners-Convicts in the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution are seeking extension of Parole.

The petitioners-convicts have been convicted and sentenced to undergo imprisonment in different cases. They were granted interim Parole in view of the decision by the High Powered Committee, Haryana in the wake of the COVID Pandemic Conditions. The applicants/Convicts were directed to report back to the Jail Authorities, hence the present petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the Petitioners submits that High Powered Committee has taken the decision of further

extension till 31.12.2020, hence the present writ petition has become infructuous.
