Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to issue the Passport to the petitioner.

Mr.Jain and Mr.Gill accept notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 & 3, respectively.

From the perusal of the writ petition, it does not come forth that the petitioner has applied or not.

Counsel for the petitioner concededly submits that the petitioner has not applied but is apprehensive of rejection of the same on various grounds on account of his conviction on an earlier occasion.

This Court is of the opinion that the petitioner is premature as firstly the petitioner has not applied and secondly his case has not been rejected. It is only in either of the eventuality, the cause of action would arise to him.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed, at this stage, without observing anything on merits.
