A joint application for disposal of the appeal in terms of amicable settlement between the parties. Allowed as prayed for. Main appeal is taken on Board.

**FAO-116-2012**

Learned counsel for the appellants has pointed out that Smt. Sudesh Rani-appellant no.2 has already expired. She was mother of late Sh. Ashok Kumar @ Ashok Bansal (deceased). The claimants have filed this appeal seeking enhancement of the compensation. Learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal has allowed the petition and determined the compensation at Rs.9,50,000/-.

The joint application is signed by the learned counsel for the appellants and respondent no.3. An affidavit of Deputy Manager, National Insurance Company Limited has been filed in support of the application.

Sh. Munish Mittal, learned counsel representing the appellant no. 1 and 3 states that he has instructions to make a statement to this effect.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the appeal is disposed of in terms of para 2 and 3 of the application. It has been noticed that the Insurance Company has agreed to pay enhanced amount of Rs.5 lacs over and above, what was determined by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal towards full and final settlement within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order. The amount shall be paid by way of account payee cheque in favour of appellants no. 1 and 3.

The appeal stands disposed of in the abovesaid terms.
