This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing
due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

This order shall dispose of CM-7807-CII of 2020 in/and FAO No.
5163 of 2011 and FAO No.6958 of 2011. Both the appeals arise out of award
dated 12.05.2011, passed by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal,
Bhiwani (for short 'tribunal').

Applicant-appellant-Rajmal, filed a petition under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicle Act, seeking compensation on account of the injuries received by him in a motor vehicle accident. Learned tribunal, as per the impugned decision dated 12.05.2011, awarded a sum of Rs. 1,14, 460/- to the claimant alongwith interest at the rate of 6% per annum, from the date of filing of the petition till realization.

Learned counsel for the parties, submit that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties, before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 26.11.2019. Terms and conditions of the settlement arrived at between the parties were reduced into writing. Copy of the compromise dated 26.11.2019, is attached with the file of FAO No. 5163 of 2011. Amount of Rs.1,70, 000/- as agreed upon, has been received by the claimant-Rajmal. The parties agree to remain bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement. It is thus prayed that both the appeals be disposed of in terms of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

In view of compromise dated 26.11.2019 arrived at between the parties, both the appeals i.e., FAO No. 5163 of 2011 and FAO No. 6958 of 2011 as well as CM-7807-CII of 2020, stands disposed of.
