1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 29.05.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.1, thereby dismissing the revision petition preferred by the petitioner against the order dated 20.10.2015 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Collector, Gurdaspur thereby dismissing the appeal filed by the petitioner against order dated 11.02.2014 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.3 with a further prayer to set aside the orders dated 29.05.2019, 20.10.2015 and 11.02.2014.

2. A bare perusal of the paper book shows that the petitioner is having the alternate statutory remedy of revision before the Financial Commissioner and, in fact, the petitioner has even filed the revision

before that authority. The petitioner cannot be permitted to maintain two parallel proceedings for the same cause of action.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed. However, the dismissal of the present petition would not prejudice the rights of the petitioner in his revision which is stated to be pending before the Financial Commissioner, Punjab.
