Learned State counsel has handed over copy of report dated 14.12.2020 given by the Tehsildar as well as copy of judgment passed by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP No.8409 of 2020, titled as **Lalit Mehta vs. State of Haryana and others**, (decided on 01.12.2020).

As per report of the Tehsildar, land bearing Khasra No.46/23 and 60/3 is not the ownership of petitioner. It is the ownership of Balwinder Singh and Chhinder Kaur. Further, the land of petitioner is situated at a distance of 200 Karams (about 1100 feet) from the Transmission Line, 132 KV. CWP No.8409 of 2020 filed by Lalit Mehta has been dismissed by observing that 80% of the work has already been completed.

Since the land does not belong to the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition.
