Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to get the detainee, namely, Nishu Rani, wife of the petitioner, released from the illegal custody of respondent No. 4.

It was averred in the petition that the petitioner solemnized his marriage with Nishu on 30.10.2020 and they filed CRWP-9072-2020 for protection of their life and liberty, which was disposed of vide order dated 4.11.2020 with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into their grievance expressed in the representation. It was further averred that when after their marriage, the petitioner and detainee Nisha were living happily, her father along with 30-40 assailants had raided their house and taken away the detainee along forcibly and without her consent.

Vide order dated 07.11.2020 passed by this Court, a Warrant Officer was appointed to visit the premises of respondent No. 4 to know the status of the aforesaid detainee.

In compliance thereof, the Warrant Officer submitted a report dated 10.11.2020, stating therein that the premises of respondent No. 4- father of the detainee was raided and the detainee was recovered from there. The statement of Nishu Rani was got recorded wherein she stated that she did not want to stay with her parents and requested to allow her to go with her husband-petitioner and accordingly, she was sent with her husband-petitioner.

In view of the fact that the detainee has been handed over to her husband, no further orders are called for in the present petition.

The present petition is, accordingly, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
