Prayer in this writ petition is for directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to take action on the representation dated 23.07.2019 submitted by the petitioner attached as (Annexure P1) with this writ petition.

It is averred in the said representation that vehicles are parked in front of the petitioner's house without his permission, which are causing nuisance to the petitioner and his family members. Status report by way of affidavit dated 29.11.2019 was filed. It is mentioned therein that the petitioner himself recorded his statement to the effect that he had submitted a complaint against unknown persons, who had parked their vehicles outside his house. In this regard, the Panchayat had explained to the said persons and the petitioner no longer wished to take any action on his application as the land where the vehicles are parked is a Government property. Learned counsel for the petitioner on 27.01.2020 had sought an adjournment to verify whether the writ petition was rendered infructuous in this view of the matter.

Today, despite the matter being called twice, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Keeping in the view the fact as aforementioned and the statement attached as Annexure R1 with affidavit dated 29.11.2019, which is not controverted, I do not find any reason or ground for continuance of the present proceedings.

Present writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of. Needless to say, in case of subsistence of any grievance as raised in Annexure P1, the petitioner is at liberty to avail the remedy/remedies as may be available to him in accordance with law.
