The aforesaid writ petitions shall stand decided by this common order. However, for convenience the facts have been taken from CWP-2861-2015.

Affidavit of Pardeep Kumar, Director Elementary Education, Haryana, Panchkula dated 3.3.2020 has been filed in Court today stating therein that the petitioners have already deposited CPF alongwith interest in the pension Head account of Government and therefore, the pension case of the petitioners has already been received. Relaxation in Rule 3(1) of the Haryana Aided School (Special Pension and Contributory Provident Fund Rules 2001) too has been granted, so that pensionary benefits could be

granted to the petitioners after completing the required formalities.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-State to release the pension and other retiral dues within a period of two months alongwith interest @ 6% per annum from the date it was due uptill it is paid.
