Through instant petition, the petitioner is seeking regular bail in case FIR No.127 dated 25.06.2018 under Sections 379-B (2) and 411 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Moti Nagar, Ludhiana.

The case has been registered on the basis of secret information to the effect that the petitioner alongwith co-accused indulged in snatching of mobile phone by moving on the scooter. Petitioner alongwith co-accused were apprehended.

It has been stated that four mobile phones and scooter have been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The similarly placed co-accused, namely, Rajinder Singh @ Raju has been granted regular bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 13.02.2019 passed in CRM-M-5773-2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mewa Singh, has not been able to distinguish the case of the present petitioner with the case of co-accused, who has already been granted bail.

The arrest of the petitioner was effected on 25.06.2018. Investigation of the case is complete and challan has been presented in the Court.

In view of the above, but without commenting any further on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
