The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.658 dated 09.09.2020, under Sections 363, 366, 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Karnal, district Karnal.

On 11.11.2020, a Coordinate Bench of this Court has passed the following order:-

'Case is taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.658 dated 09.09.2020 registered under Sections 363,366 and 380 IPC at Police Station Sadar Karnal, District Karnal.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he has illicit relation with Baljeet Kaur wife of the complainant. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the complainant had ill-treated his wife Baljeet Kaur, as a result of which she had moved a representation dated 21.10.2020 (Annexure P2) to the Senior Superintendent of

Police, Karnal against him. Baljeet Kaur has also filed a divorce petition against the complainant, which is pending adjudication before the court concerned. It is further submitted that in order to hide his guilt against his wife, the complainant has levelled false allegations of the petitioner's having illicit relation with the wife of the complainant, whereas the facts stated above would show that no case of kidnapping is made out.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.'

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Virender Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 11.11.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
