Rekha Mittal, J.

Counsel for the petitioners inter alia contends that all the petitioners have been allowed benefit of pensionary scheme as was in vogue prior to 01.04.2004, the amount contributed by them towards CPF is liable to be refunded. He has submitted that the petitioners would be satisfied in case some time bound directions are issued to respondent No.2 to decide the legal Notice (Annexure P-6).

Taking into consideration the limited prayer made by counsel, but without examining merits of the controversy, petition stands disposed of. The Director General of Police, Punjab-respondent No.2 is directed to ensure that a final decision is taken in the matter, in view of averments raised in the legal notice, at the level of competent authority, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
