On 24.1.2020, this Court had directed the Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar, to file reply with regard to the fact that why there was delay in the examination of prosecution witnesses.

The Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar, has filed his affidavit wherein, it has been stated that there were total 11 prosecution witnesses in the present matter out of which 6 witnesses were not summoned being unnecessary and summons were issued to remaining 5 witnesses. It has been further stated that the summoned witnesses did not appear before the Court and consequently, even warrants were also issued against them. It has also been stated in the affidavit that now the entire

evidence is complete and even the departmental proceedings have also been initiated against the erring officials who have been named in para 3 of the affidavit.

Since the prosecution evidence is already complete and the trial is near conclusion, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the present petition at this stage, and prays for withdrawal of the same.
