Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 23.01.2019 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action against respondents No.4 to 6, in accordance with law.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Rural), Ferozepur, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, filed in the Court today, submits that the dispute between the petitioner and the private respondents is subjudiced before the Civil Court, in a civil suit filed by the petitioner against M/s Farid Commission Agent and the same is pending. It is further stated in the affidavit that on an earlier occasion, the petitioner had given a complaint dated 31.07.2017 with the allegations that

he used to sell the crop through the commission agency of respondent No.6 Jail Singh and he had obtained his blank cheques and by misusing the same, has filed a complaint on the basis of said blank cheques. In the inquiry of said complaint, conducted by EO Wing, Ferozepur, it was found that complaint was filed by respondents No.4 & 5 and not by respondent No.6. It is also stated in the affidavit that representation dated 23.01.2019 was never received by the police authorities.

In view of the above, no further action is called for, in the present petition and the same is rendered as infructuous.
