The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.403 dated 20.08.2020, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 341 and 506 IPC (Sections 452, 427 and 326 IPC added subsequently), registered at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the petitioner is named in the FIR but he is stated to be empty handed and no specific injury has been attributed to him. The petitioner is in custody since his arrest on 28.09.2020.

Learned State counsel states that the matter is under investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner was unarmed and no specific injury has been attributed to him, he is in custody for over a month, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
