The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.229, dated 23rd May, 2020, registered under Sections 394, 397, 201, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25/54 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sector-58, Faridabad.

2. The Petitioner has remained in custody since his arrest from the spot itself on 22nd May, 2020.
3. After completion of investigation, Challan against him has already been submitted.
4. Co-accused persons, namely Rocky (in CRM-M No.28699 of 2020) and Amit (in CRM-M No.34613 of 2020) have already been granted Regular Bail by this Court on 23rd September, 2020 and 4th November, 2020, respectively.

5. There is no record of the Petitioner's involvement in any other criminal case, on account of which, this Court is of the opinion that he may not indulge in any other criminal act, if released on bail, at this stage.

6. In the circumstances, without commenting upon the other merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial is likely to take a considerable time to conclude in view of the on-going Covid-19 Pandemic, at this stage, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the Petitioner for an indefinite period is not justified. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
