The petitioner-wife has applied for the transfer of the petition bearing No.HMA-68-2020 (Harinder Singh Vs. Gurpreet Kaur) filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the Family Court at Amritsar to the Family Court at Ludhiana.

As per office report, notice sent to the respondent through his counsel in the trial Court, has been received back served. However, the respondent is not represented.

This Court has been informed that the respondent-husband is already defending 3 following cases at District Court, Ludhiana:-

- 1) A petition filed by the wife under Section 125 Cr.P.C.
- 2) A complaint filed under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.

3) There is FIR dated 25.11.2020 pending against the respondent.

It is also claimed that the petitioner has a four years old daughter and she does not have sufficient means to come and defend the petition at Amritsar.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to order transfer of the case bearing No. HMA-68-2020 (Harinder Singh Vs. Gurpreet Kaur) from the Family Court at Amritsar to the Family Court at Ludhiana.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Family Court on 29.01.2021.

The Family Court, Amritsar is requested to remit the case file to the Family Court at Ludhiana.

In view of the above, the present transfer application is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of, in view of the above-stated order.
