All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. seeking 'regular bail' for the petitioner in case FIR no. 124, dated 10.07.2020, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no other criminal case stands registered against the petitioner, with him having been in custody for more than 04 months and with the recovery alleged to have been made from him being only marginally above commercial quantity.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Kewal Singh, does not deny the factual position, though otherwise he obviously opposes the grant of bail to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above and also the situation of the current pandemic, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
