The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the orders dated 12.1.2009 and 16.10.2020.

Since, the order of fresh enquiry has been passed, no useful purpose would be served to proceed with the present contempt petition. In fact, similar contempt petition bearing COCP No.2170 of 2018 titled as Bal Krishan vs. Alka Meena and others, was also dismissed vide order dated 30.7.2018 as no contempt having been made out.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to avail alternative remedy challenging the order of fresh enquiry, if so deemed fit in accordance with law.

However, the order directing fresh enquiry be sent to learned counsel for the petitioner/petitioner within a week from today.
