**REKHA MITTAL, J. (Oral)**

Counsel for State of Haryana would inform that as per policy decision of the State Government, displaced extension lecturers can apply on the portal provided for the purpose but in the instant case, the petitioner neither applied on the portal nor made any representation to the authorities. He would further inform that in case the petitioner applies on the portal, her case would be considered and decided in view of the policy decision of the State Government.

Counsel for the petitioner, in response, would state that the petition may be disposed of but with liberty to the petitioner to apply on the portal provided for the purpose but some time bound directions may be issued to the authority concerned to take a decision in the matter.

In view of the above, without examining merits of the case, the present petition stands disposed of. The petitioner may apply on the portal provided for adjustment of displaced extension lecturers. In case she applies within a period of one month, her case will be considered by the competent authority and final decision would be taken in the matter, in accordance with law.

However, nothing stated hereinbefore shall be construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case. It is clarified that in case plea of the petitioner is not accepted and she takes recourse to remedy in law, it would be open for the respondents to take all possible/plausible defences.
