The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to compute the contract period from 01.11.1986 to 02.01.2006 followed by regular service upto 31.12.2018 to be treated as qualifying service for computing pension and pensionary benefits and to release the pension and pensionary benefits along with arrears with 24% interest

per annum to the petitioner considering the case of petitioner under old pension scheme in lieu of judgments delivered vide orders dated 31.08.2010, 01.03.2019 and 10.05.2019 (Annexures P-3, P-4 and P-5, respectively) and to decide the legal notice dated 16.07.2020 (Annexure P-10).
