The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioners have prayed for issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents for protecting their civil/personal rights and liberties from being invaded by the private respondents. Petitioners are alleged to have solemnized marriage on 09.11.2020 on attaining the age of majority. They feel reasonable apprehension and threat perception at the hands of the private respondents and pray that their personal/civil rights be not violated by them.

Precisely, in the context of aforesaid relief, petitioners have approached the Senior Superintendent of Police,

Kapurthala /respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 09.11.2020.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.Jaspreet Kaur, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State-respondents No.1 to 3.

There is some shortcoming in respect of date on which the representation was sent to Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala/ respondent No.2. The mode of sending such representation is also on questionable note. Be that as it may, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.2 by way of fresh representation. In the event of receiving such representation, respondent No.2 shall proceed to decide the same in accordance with law.

This order shall not debar the official respondents from proceeding against any of the parties, if they are involved in any other case.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
