This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, in case FIR No.253 dated 01.06.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 452, 506 and 120-B of the IPC and 25 of Arms Act 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Sonapat, District Sonapat.

[2]. Petitioner has remained in detention for more than 05 months since 07.06.2020, after completion of investigation challan against him has already been presented.

[3]. Learned counsel for the petitioner draws attention of the Court to the fact that there is no allegation in the FIR to the effect that his client had personally used any firearm against the complainant/victim.

[4]. In the circumstances, without commenting upon the other merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial is likely to take a

considerable time to conclude in view of the on-going Covid-19 Pandemic, at this stage, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is not justified. As such, he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
