The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

The petitioner Satish Kumar aged about 44 years has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* seeking a direction to consider him for promotion to the post of TGT Sanskrit from the date his juniors were promoted w.e.f. 17.07.2018 with all consequential benefits.

The petitioner belongs to Dhanak caste which has been declared as SC caste. Learned counsel based upon the pleadings submits that the petitioner possesses qualification of Matric with Hindi as subject and two years' Diploma in Education. She submits that the petitioner also possesses BA/B.Ed. degree. It is submitted that since the petitioner was qualified for the post of JBT Teacher, the petitioner was appointed as JBT teacher on 08.07.2004. Learned counsel then refers to two orders/judgments of this Court passed in (i) **CWP No.12143 of 2016 (Suresh Chander & Ors. vs. State of Haryana & Ors.)** decided on 12.09.2018 and (ii) **CWP No.10054 of 2016 (Mahesh Kumar vs. State of Haryana & Ors.)** decided on 23.04.2019 (P9 & P10, respectively).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the

dated 15.05.2020 (P11) which has not been decided by the authorities till date.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition by directing the competent authority to consider and decide the petitioner's claim as raised in legal notice (P11) as early as possible and preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
