RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed by the petitioners in the nature of public interest for issuance of a direction to the respondents to implement the provisions of "National Building Code-2005" amended upto date in the area of District Panchkula as well as to seal the gas agencies/other establishments, who are running without No Objection Certificate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that to redress his grievances, the petitioner has already served the respondent-authorities with legal notices dated 23.06.2020 and 31.07.2020 (Annexures P-3 and P-5) as well as a representation dated 01.09.2020 (Annexure P-6) but despite that no action has been taken as yet.

Learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Haryana submits that the concerned authority shall consider and take a decision on the legal notices dated 23.06.2020 and 31.07.2020 (Annexures P-3 and P-5) as well as on the representation dated 01.09.2020 (Annexure P-6) filed by the petitioner at the earliest and decision thereof would be communicated to the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Haryana, the petition stands disposed of.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and therefore, the respondent-authorities would be at liberty to examine the matter keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter accept or reject the same in accordance with law.
