[1] Prayer in the petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner on the post of Mali-cum-Chowkidar in terms of the Punjab *Ad hoc*, Contractual, Daily Wage, Temporary, Work Charged and Outsourced Employees Welfare Act, 2016, as also in view of the case of the petitioner having been recommended by respondent No.4 for regularization to respondent No.2.

[2] Learned counsel further states that as per reply filed by the respondents, the matter is under the active consideration of respondent No.2 and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.

[3] Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner for regularization, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible.
