Prayer in this writ petition is for issuance of a writ, order or direction to respondents no.1 to 4 to provide protection to the petitioner in carrying out its business activities and to ensure that no hindrance is caused therein by the private respondents.

As per the reply filed by way of affidavit dated 12.02.2019 of Rachhpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Payal, District Ludhiana, on behalf of respondent no.4, it is mentioned that the applications/complaints filed by the parties were investigated. The parties in question compromised the matter and withdrew their respective complaints. The said applications/complaints were consigned being compromised. Copy of the joint statement of the parties is attached as Annexure R-1/T with the reply.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no instructions in regard to the compromise.
