2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating action against the respondents for willful disobedience of order (Annexure P-1) dated 24.08.2020 in CWP No.12616 of 2020.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the legal notice (Annexure P-2) dated 10.06.2020 has been decided by the respondents and payment claimed made to the petitioner, therefore, he does not press the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to take out appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law, for claiming interest on the delayed payment.
4. ***Dismissed as withdrawn*** with the liberty, as prayed for.
