ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking interim bail for four weeks on the ground that the marriage of his son is to be performed on 06/07.12.2020.

The petitioner is an accused in FIR No.0047 dated 24.05.2019, under Sections 21, 25 and 31 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Sadar Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that 275 grams of heroin was allegedly recovered from his pocket. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act and has referred to the copy of the invitation card at Annexure P-2 and Panchayat certificate at Annexure P-4. He also contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted interim bail for the marriage of his daughter by the order of this Court dated 22.11.2019 in a petition bearing CRM No.M-49076-2019 and he had promptly surrendered and had not misused the concession. Copy of the order is at Annexure P-5.

Learned State counsel has filed short affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Nawanshahr on behalf of respondent No.1 wherein the factum of marriage of the son of the petitioner has been verified. It is also stated that the petitioner is involved in several other cases including those under the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is ready to furnish heavy surety for his release on interim bail.

Heard.

It is, thus, manifest that the marriage of the son of the petitioner is to be performed on 06./07.12.2020 and, therefore, the presence of the petitioner in connection therewith would be necessary.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail for a period of 7 days on his furnishing heavy surety to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner shall be released on interim bail on 04.12.2020 and he shall report back at the Central Jail, Ludhiana by 05:00 p.m. on 11.12.2020.
