The petitioner has filed this writ petition for issuance of a direction to the respondents to metalize the Katcha Raasta (Gohar) to provide mid sector crossing to Jan Marg running between Sector 52 and Sector 53 Chandigarh, details of which have been mentioned in the writ petition as well as in the representation (Annexure P-5).

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the said *Rasta* is within the jurisdiction of Municipal Corporation-respondent No.2 and that the representation (Annexure P-5) shall be decided by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.

Thus, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Municipal Corporation to decide the pending representation dated 03.08.2020(Annexure P-5) within four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Till then, the said road shall not be blocked.
