The prayer of the petitioner, in the present writ petition, is that the petitioner has applied for the transfer of registration of vehicle No.HR-69 C-6247 after completing the due formalities required to be done in the said regard but, no action is being taken by respondent No.3 in the said regard and that too without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that once a form No.36/37 required for the transfer of the registration of a vehicle has been filed by the petitioner, it becomes duty of respondent No.3 to pass appropriate order on the said request but in the present case, the respondents have failed to perform the said duty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already approached respondent No.2 raising the said grievance by filing a representation dated 07.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) which is still pending consideration with the said authority and the petitioner will

be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection for deciding the representation dated 07.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) by respondent No.2 in a time bound manner by passing appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 07.08.2020 (Annexure P-4), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 07.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) within a period of four weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
