The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take action against respondents No.4 to 20 by arresting them in case FIR No.39 dated 31.04.2019 registered under Sections 452, 323, 427, 342, 506, 379, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Banur, District Patiala.

Status report on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 by way of affidavit of Sh. Akashdeep Singh Aulakh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rajpura, District Patiala has been filed on the last date of hearing.
