The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 to 18 regarding the grievances raised by the petitioner in his initial representation dated 27.08.2020 (Annexure P-2) followed by reminder representation dated 30.9.2020 (Annexure P-3) as the private respondents benefitted themselves to the tune of Rs.10.00 crores from the petitioners by alluring them to invest their hard earned money in the schemes floated by the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset relied upon the order passed by co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-30515 of 2020, titled 'Ram Pal and another vs. State of Punjab and others', decided on

30.09.2020 wherein similar controversy was involved against the same respondents.

He has further submitted that in the present case also the petitioners were duped of Rs.10.00 crores and they had filed a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur as well as to the SHO, Police Station City, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur but no action has been taken by the police in this regard.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At this stage, Mr. Bhupinder Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to the official respondents to decide the representation in a time bound manner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondent No.2 i.e. SSP, Hoshiarpur to look into the grievance of the petitioner as contained in his representation (Annexure P-3) and in case any action is warranted in accordance with law then the needful may be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of.
